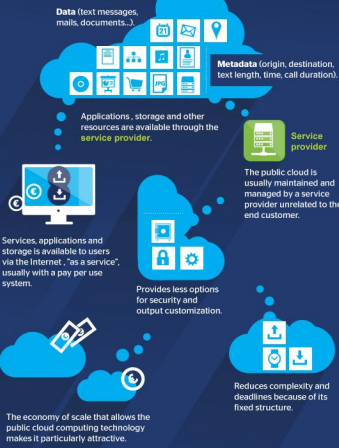
public, private or hybrid?

- 4 Application integration with other business functions.

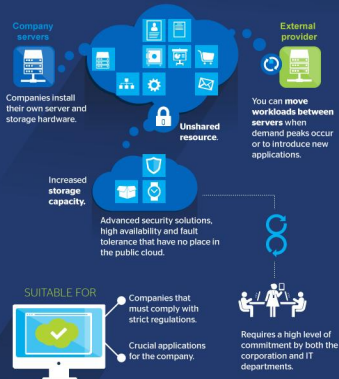
PUBLIC CLOUD
