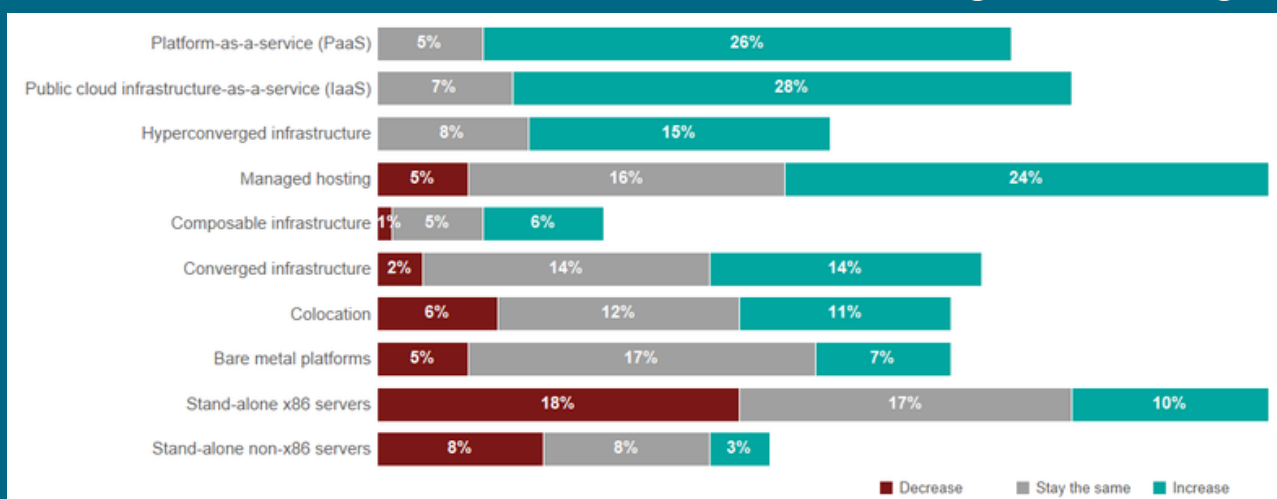

Compute capacity changes in 2019 > Massive increases in PaaS, IaaS and Managed Hosting

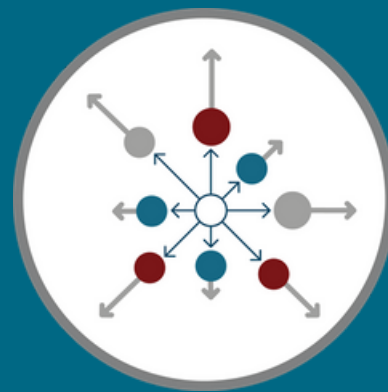


Digital Transformation becomes mainstream

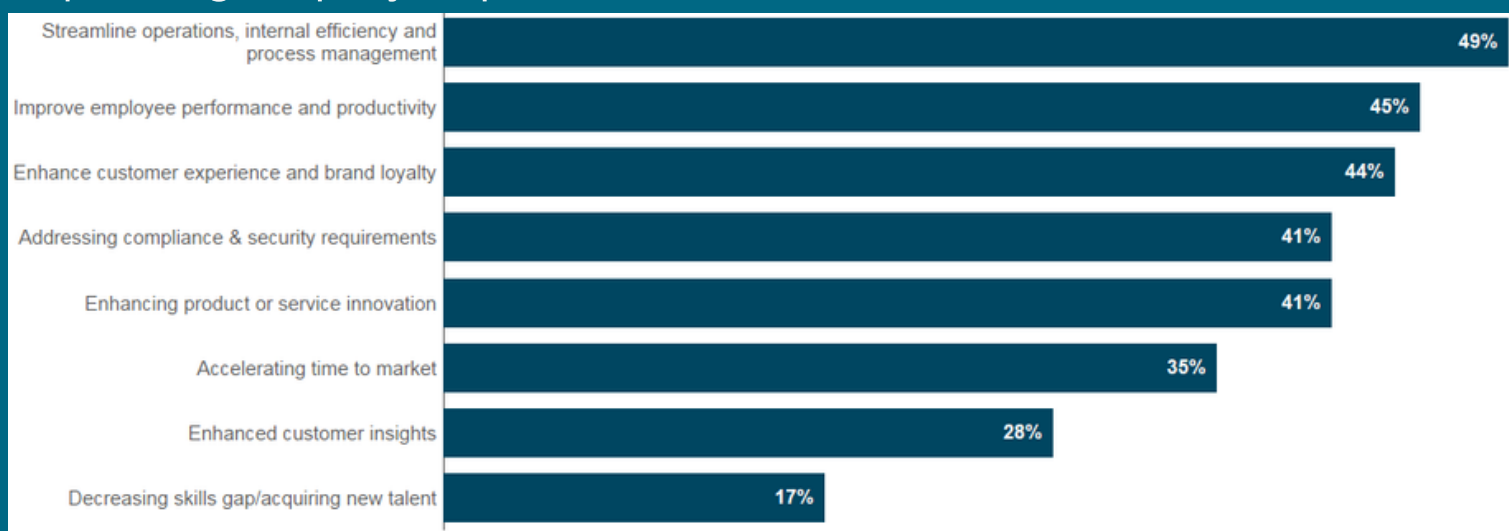
92% of companies are taking on a form of digital transformation

Security becomes about education

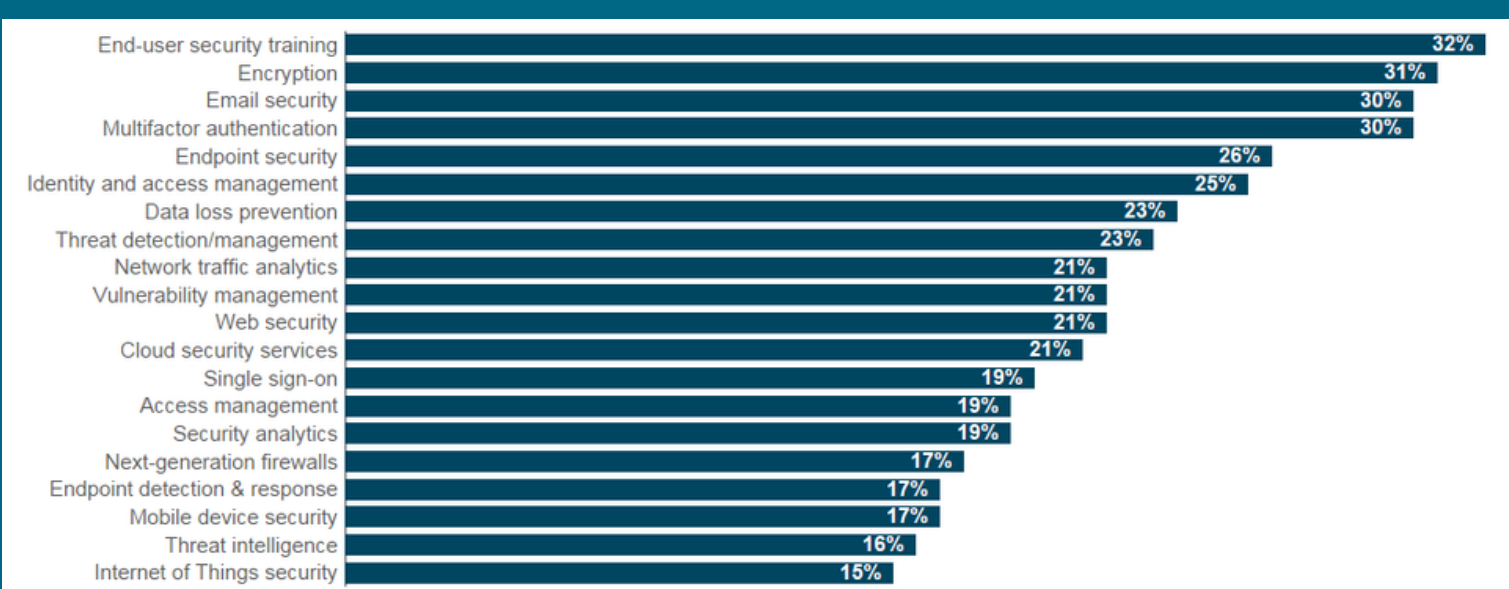
Focus in 2019 went from GDPR to monitoring and securing user behaviour
