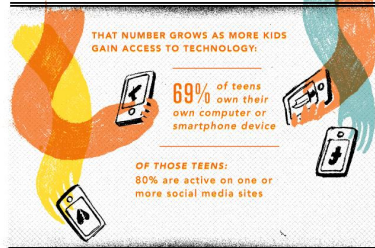

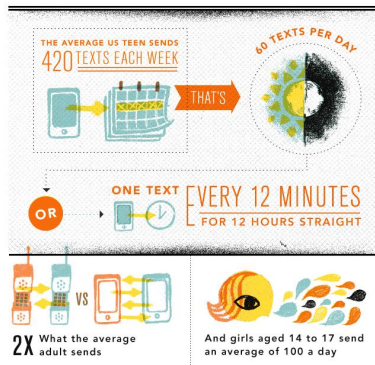
HOW BULLIES HAVE MOVED FROM THE PLAYGROUND TO THE WEB
